Potential Leaders should possess effective communication skills, leadership potential, be responsible, and enjoy helping others succeed. **Students applying must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.5 with no "N's" or "U's" in citizenship.** We would like for you to be involved in our program. You could have a tremendous influence on the students you work with and will learn many valuable leadership skills in the process. Plus, it will be fun!!

WHAT DOES A WEB LEADER DO?

Leaders are trained to work with the incoming seventh grade class and other new students who are entering ARIS next fall. After two days of training, **WEB Leader** students help run seventh grade orientation before school starts in August. At the orientation, each Leader will be given the task of directing new students to various stations on campus and providing them with a campus tour. **WEB Leader** students will also help new seventh graders during their first year of middle school with any challenges they may face. Periodically during the school year, Leaders will meet again with seventh graders to touch base and support them throughout the year. We know that the more contact seventh graders have with **WEB Leader** students, the more successful they become. **WEB Leader** students will plan/organize 7th grade social activities, lead monthly Wolf Pack Pride Group activities and lessons, be a peer mentor, and so much more. **As a member of the WEB Leader class, students will be REQUIRED to attend all socials, participate in all dress up days, support all school activities, and ATTEND ALL MANDATORY DAYS (listed below).**
